## **GALA PLANNING MEETING**

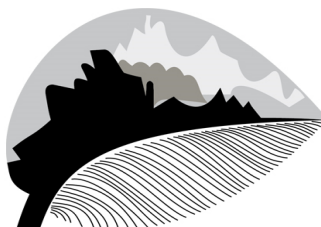
**Tomorrow—3pm**

Yesterday was Market Day. We made lolly lei. I got a Maori burger. I got books. **By Moses Tohu.**

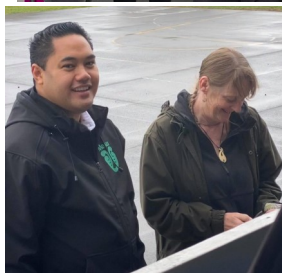
